
# **TERMS CS&D Programme SEMINAR SERIES**

# Cancer, Stem cells & Developmental biology



### Whom to invite?

First-class scientists and speakers only.

### Procedure of invitation

Contact the co-chairs of the seminar committee, Puck Knipscheer and Mike Boxem with suggestions for speakers. Indicate for each the topic and model system used, as well as a brief motivation for your interest. The seminar committee will select the speakers to be invited, thereby aiming to achieve a constantly high quality of science and presentations and a good coverage of important and relevant topics. If your proposal is accepted, you can invite the speaker on behalf of the CS&D Programme.

The invited guest should have his/her own research group and have some seniority in the field. A bare minimum is a publication from the group as last author.

### Host

When you suggest and invite a speaker you must also act as his/her host. Both project leaders and PhD students are welcome to suggest and host speakers. In particular PhD students are encouraged to contribute: hosting a speaker is an inspiring experience and many big names more readily accept invitations coming from PhD students. Seminars may be combined with a journal club on the speaker's papers before the seminar and a discussion with the speaker afterwards. Student-invited seminars would be particularly attractive for this approach.

### Information

At the time of invitation the host will provide the secretariat with the name, affiliation and email address of the speaker. A title should be provided at least 2 months prior to the seminar, a short abstract must be provided at least 1 month prior to the seminar.

# **Duration**

45 minutes, followed by questions and discussion.

### **Travel**

The CS&D Programme will reimburse economy class airfare ONLY, no sustenance costs will be refund. For travel to/from the airport, train is the preferred mode of transportation. Parking costs will not be reimbursed.

### Accommodation

For speakers from abroad, a hotel room can be reserved for a maximum of two nights. The host is responsible for booking the hotel, preferably the Malie Hotel. When making the reservation, indicate that is for the CS&D and ask that the bill be sent directly to the school's secretariat. The following hotels have agreed to this procedure:

### Drinks and dinner

Following the seminar, the host may take the speaker out for drinks and dinner and invite maximum 2-3 people from his/her lab.

### Allowable costs

Please note that only those speakers who present a seminar in the context of the Thursday seminar series are eligible to receive a fee. Speakers presenting a seminar in the context of a CS&D course will not receive a fee, with the exception of speakers that have been approved by the (co-) chair(s) of the Seminar Committee and present their seminar on a Thursday, with the seminar being open to the entire CS&D community.

The CS&D will pay hotel/breakfast for 2 nights maximum at a maximum cost of € 130 per night. Additional nights must be paid by the host or the speaker.

The host will be reimbursed dinner with the speaker (€ 250,- max for 4-5 people)

The speaker will be reimbursed his/her own travel costs (economy class airfare only with a maximum of 2000 euro); all other expenses are at the cost of the speaker.

The total cost of a seminar will depend on the country of residence of the speaker, but is about € 1000,- on average.
